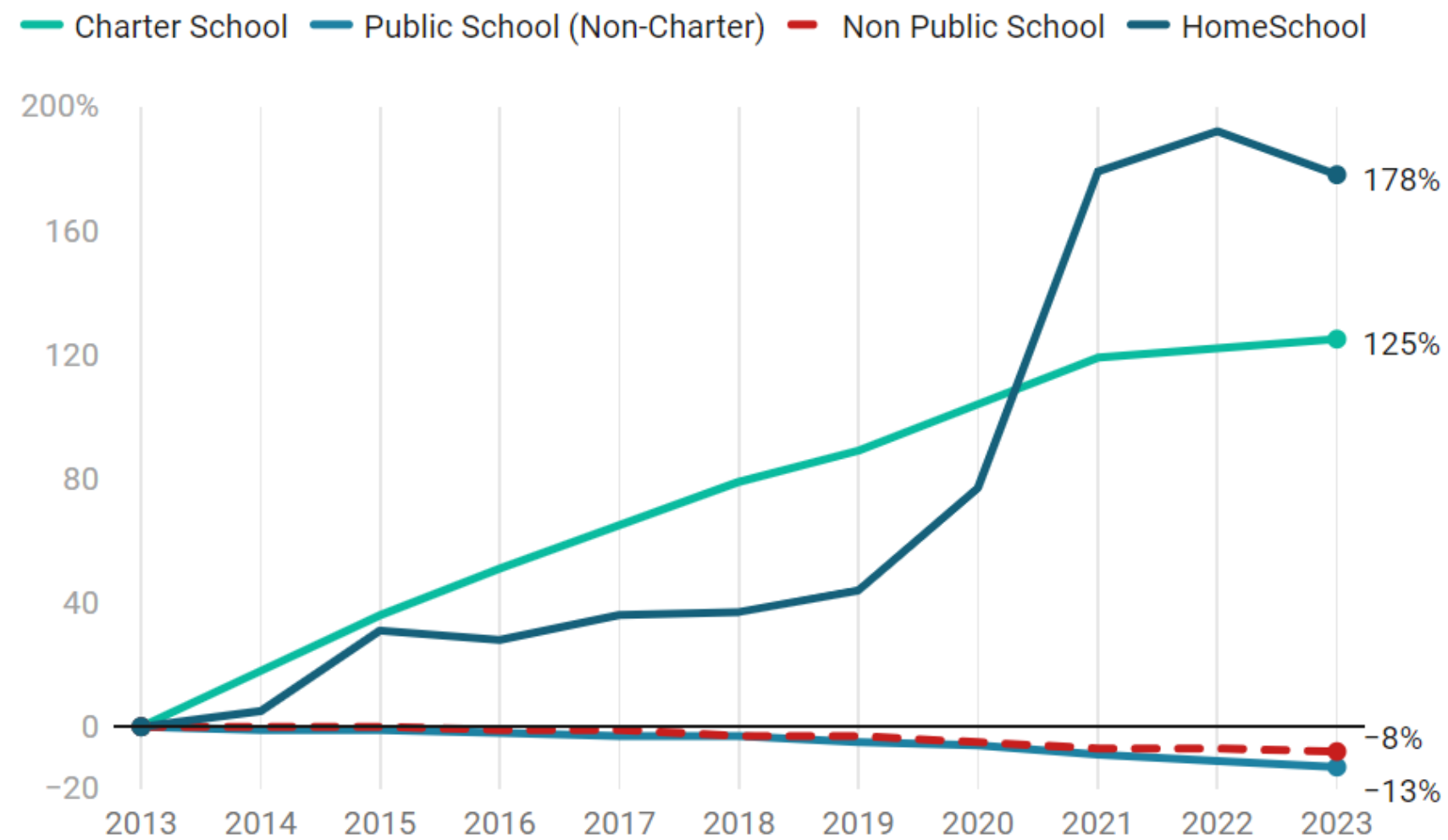

## Statewide enrollment change by school sector (2013-23)



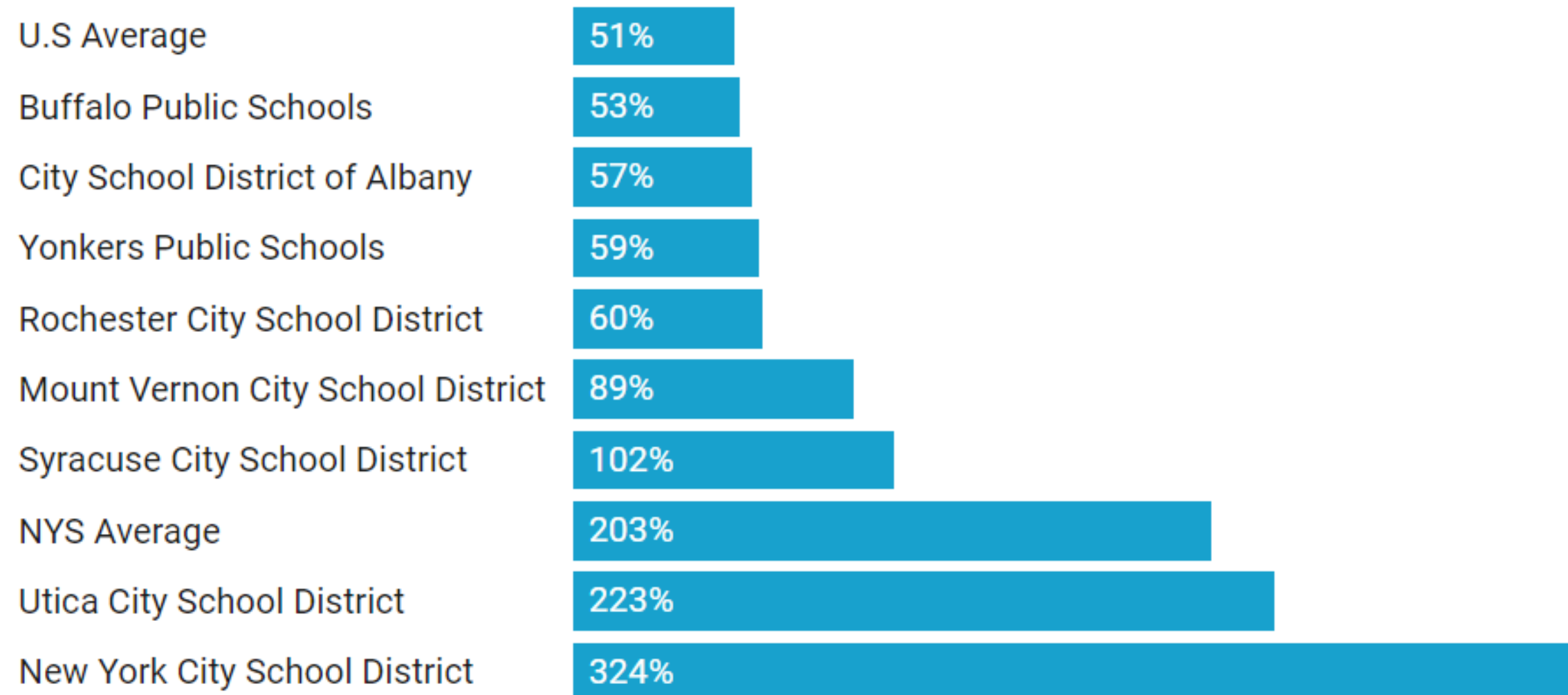
The years represent the end of the school year. For e.g., 2013 refers to the 2012-13 school year.

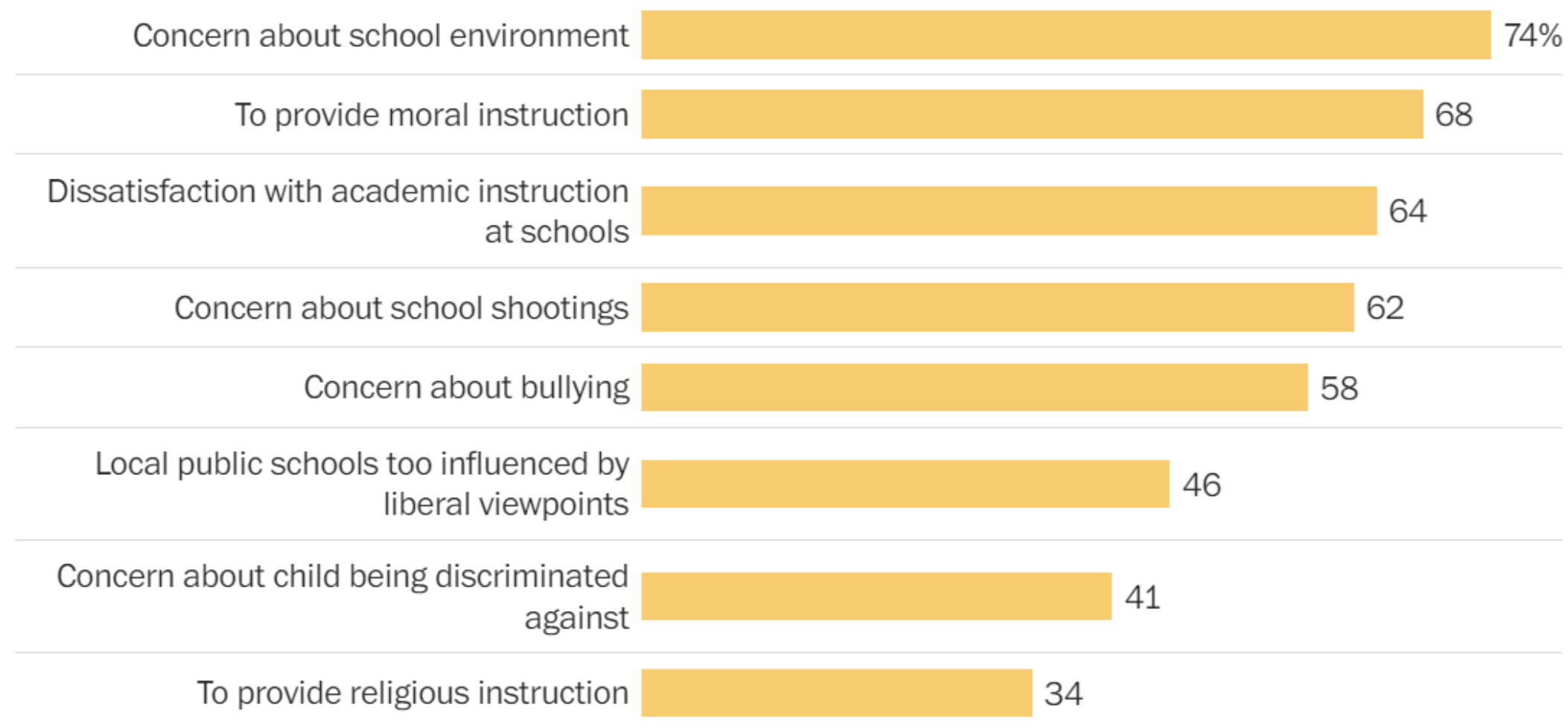

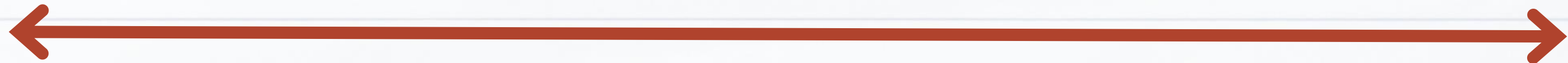

## Parent Led

- Learning time is scheduled
- Follows grade level similar to traditional school
- Designed by curriculum

## Continuum

## Child Led

- Learning time not scheduled
- Grade levels flexible
- Very different than traditional school
- Designed by family

# NYS HOME INSTRUCTION REGULATIONS

## LETTER OF INTENT



- Parent sends a notice to the superintendent of their intention to instruct child at home.
- Due by July 1st **OR** within 14 days of commencing home instruction (anytime during the year).
- School district responds within 10 days by sending copy of regulations and blank IHIP forms.



# NYS HOME INSTRUCTION REGULATIONS

## IHIP INDIVIDUALIZED HOME INSTRUCTION PLAN



- Parent prepares based on required courses (see 100.10 e) and submits IHIP to school district.
- Due by August 15th **or** within four weeks of the receipt of regulations and forms from school district.

# NYS HOME INSTRUCTION REGULATIONS

## QUARTERLY REPORTS



- Parent prepares a description of the material covered in each subject listed in the IHIP
- Parent submits a Quarterly Report to the school district for each child at dates determined by parent.

# NYS HOME INSTRUCTION REGULATIONS

## YEAR END EVALUATIONS



- Included in the 3rd Quarterly Report will be the method of annual assessment as determined by the parent.
- Assessment may include commercially published norm-referenced achievement tests (i.e., CAT or IOWA) **or** a written narrative, in accordance with the grade level of the student.
- Results of assessment should be submitted with 4th quarterly report.

# NYS HOME INSTRUCTION REGULATIONS



- Part of the NYS Education Law
- Universal for all school districts
- Universal for all homeschool parents
- Sets a *minimum* standard for graduation
- School districts **are not** required to provide curriculum, academic, or extracurricular support
- School districts **are** required to provide special services

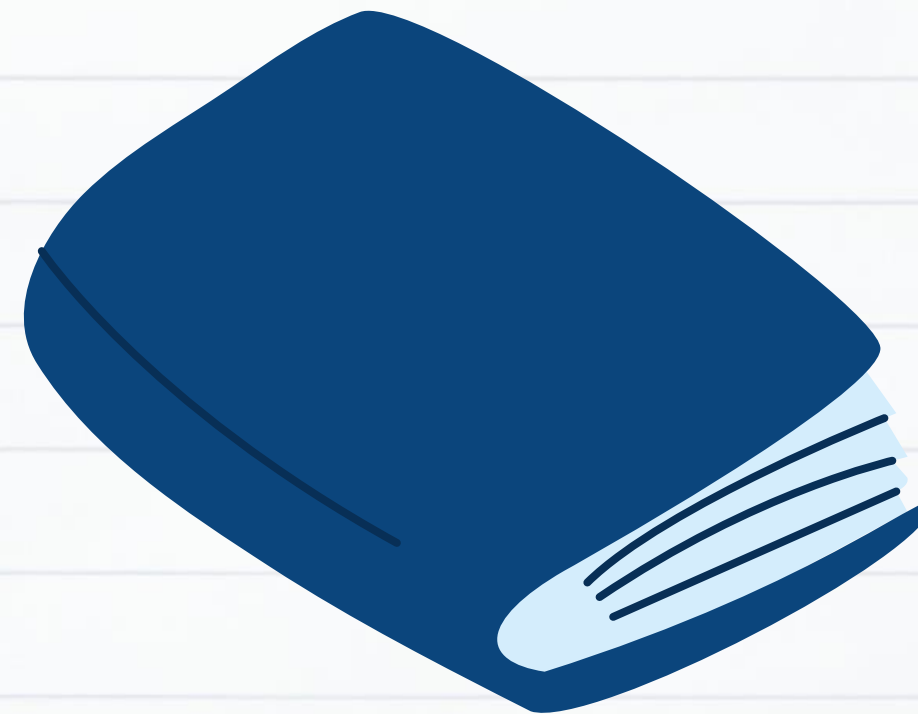

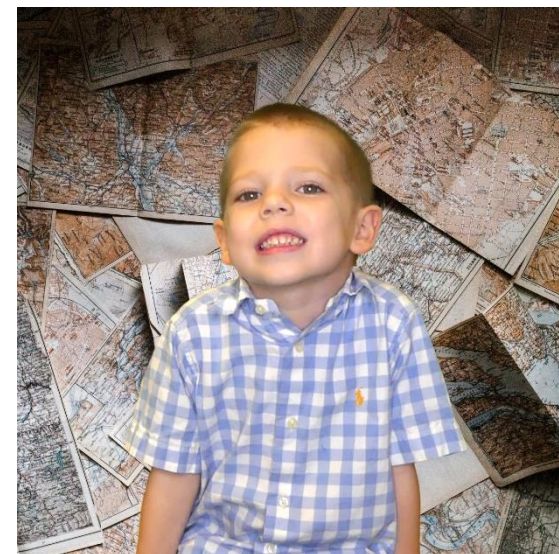

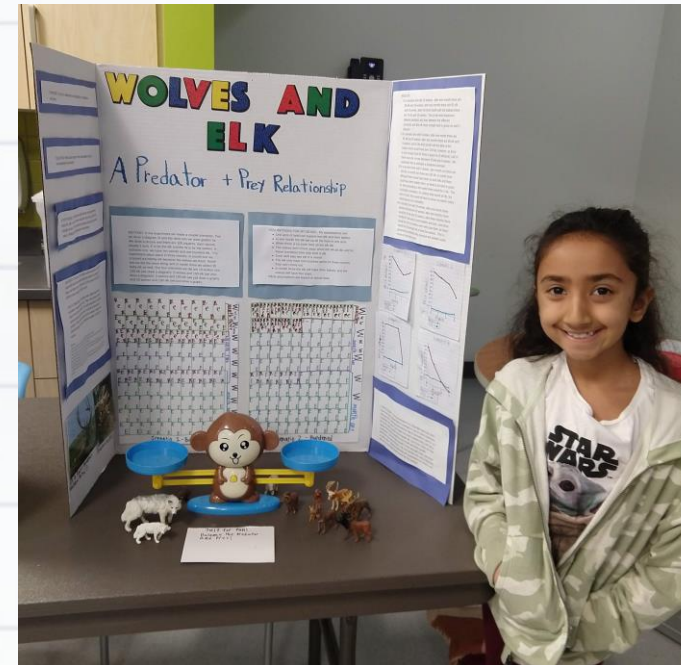
