





What does the Census data impact?

Representation of the people was, as it still is, the foremost concern. In the First Session of Congress on February 2, 1790, James Madison summed up this feeling by stating to a colleague, "I take it sir, that in order to accommodate our laws to the real situation of our constituents, we ought to be acquainted with that situation." The U.S. Census has been intended from the beginning to count ALL people in the country so that Congress can make informed decisions in its crafting of laws and policies.
