Anyone can send their comments to the NYS ConnectAll Office, describing the challenges you or others are facing because of inadequate or no available internet service to your place of residence.

Challenge the NYS Broadband Map ***All Challenges are due Thursday, April 18, 2024**

Representatives from local governments, Tribal governments, Non-Profits, and Internet Service Providers can:

- Submit challenges to identify unserved or underserved locations.
- Submit challenges to locations reported as served but not served.
- Submit challenges establishing broadband service is or will be provided to a given set of locations.
- Submit challenges to identify Community Anchor Institutions (CAIs) eligible for upgraded connectivity through the BEAD Program.
